### **Rural Girl Guiding/Girl Scouting Project in Central America**

We are delighted to send through to you the reports of the first months of the Rural Guiding Project in Central America, which the funding from Trefoil has enabled us to initiate.

We would like to highlight the key achievements to date which have been the recruitment of 'Guiding Promoters' in both Honduras and Nicaragua, an initial training for leaders from Honduras and Nicaragua, and field visits to the target groups.

We would be very interested to hear your thoughts and comments on these first quarter reports. Please let us know how we can improve the reporting for you in the next quarter. We will also be working with the Nicaraguan and Honduran associations to build up their report writing skills, as part of our wider capacity building support to them, which is an additional benefit of this project.
